Who Should Apply?

This is a two year programme designed to introduce students to the disciplines involved in early years' education.

The programme provides an introduction to a wide range of theoretical and practical skills including the developing child, children's behavior, curriculum studies, creativity and imagination, child protection, child health and practical methods of engaging children through play. Students will also have the opportunity to engage in work placement settings. Students, on successful completion of the BSc may progress to the BSc (Hons) ECCHE or choose to work within the early years' education sector.

Due to the blended learning delivery within this programme students should have access to PC broadband internet connection from home, so as to be able to fully participate in the programme.

Minimum Entry Requirements

Have obtained a full FETAC/QQI Level 6 6M2007 including distinctions in at least **three** of the following modules:

6N1942 Child Development
6N1944 Early Childhood Curriculum
6N1945 Childhood Social Legal & Health Studies
6N1973 Supervision in Early Childhood Care

Garda Vetting

Applicants who join this course will have to be vetted by the Gardaí. If the Gardaí raise an issue it will have to be addressed satisfactorily. If it is not, students will not be able to fulfil the course requirements, in which case students will be asked to leave the course. Students will also be vetted prior to placement by the relevant placement provider.

Fees

The course fees for the BSc Degree in Early Childhood Care, Health and Education Level 7 are €3,000 per annum.

To secure your place on this course, a deposit of €350 applies. The balance is paid in instalments, personal payment plans compiled.
